Declaration On the exchange of experiences and cooperation Between The City of Hiroshima and the City of Sarajevo

We hereby declare that Kazumi Matsui, Mayor of the City of Hiroshima (Japan), and Ivo Komšić Ph.D., Mayor of the City of Sarajevo (Bosnia and Herzegovina), have jointly recognized mutual interests for the promotion of a variety of exchanges and the strengthening of collaboration between our two cities, and will strive to help deepen mutual understanding and friendship between our citizens, thus contributing to lasting world peace.

In accordance with the above mentioned intention, the two cities will work on the following exchanges:

- The cities will collaborate and cooperate in the scope of peace promotion, including the Mayors for Peace activities to advance efforts toward nuclear weapons abolition and world peace.
- 2. The cities will exchange information and experiences in the fields of culture and environment.
- 3. After the exchange of information and experiences, the cities will determine the activities for implementation of, and proceed with exchange in, specific projects in the area of mutual interest of their citizens.
- 4. This Declaration enters into force when both cities have signed it.

This Declaration was made out in two copies in both the Japanese and Bosnian languages, and both copies are equally authentic.
