The Hiroshima City Emergency Evacuation Guide App is an emergency preparedness app that helps you make safe choices before natural disasters occur.

Use the app to check emergency information, such as evacuation orders, as well as risk levels where you are, and how to get to your nearest emergency evacuation site! (Automatic translations provided based on the language settings of your phone)

Learn about the different warning levels and what they mean for you!

Note: as a rule, evacuation sites will be open when Warning Level 3 or above is announced.

Warning  
Level

1

- Keep aware of the situation
- Learn about what to do in emergencies and stay prepared for disaster

Warning  
Level

2

- Flood/heavy rain/high tide advisories (etc)
- Check your emergency evacuation kit and where your nearest evacuation site is

Warning  
Level

3

Senior citizens evacuate immediately from hazard areas

- Get ready to evacuate
- Those who need more time to evacuate should begin to evacuate now along with those assisting them

Warning  
Level

4

All residents evacuate immediately from hazard areas

- Those who live in landslide hazard areas should evacuate immediately
- If you feel unsafe (regardless of where you live), evacuate somewhere safe
- If it's not possible to evacuate to an evacuation site, evacuate somewhere safe nearby (sturdy building, etc)

Level

5

Disaster in progress; take immediate action for your safety!

- At this point, it is no longer possible to evacuate safely; take actions to ensure your safety

You can also receive updates about evacuation information, evacuation sites that are open, weather information, and more via text alerts and LINE! (Japanese only)

## Evacuation Information

App displays evacuation information announced for your current location.

Senior citizens evacuate immediately from hazard areas

All residents evacuate immediately from hazard areas

Disaster in progress; take immediate action for your safety!

Risk level → High

Note: "Disaster in progress; take immediate action for your safety!" may not always be announced.



## Risk Level Information

Know your risks! Check information about risk levels in your current location (i.e., weather information, landslide hazard areas, flooding hazard areas, etc).



## Disaster Preparedness Handbook

Read the Hiroshima City disaster preparedness handbook, "Tachimachi Bōsai," where you'll find the basics of disaster preparedness, such as information about preparing for disasters and what to do in an emergency (Japanese only)



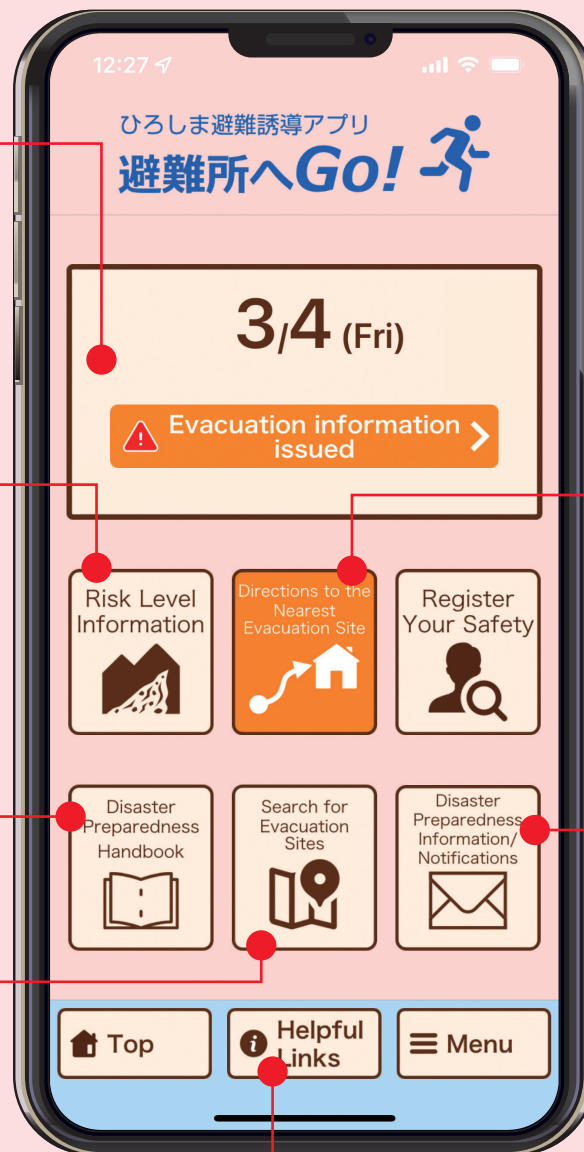
## Search for Evacuation Sites

Search for evacuation sites in your area!



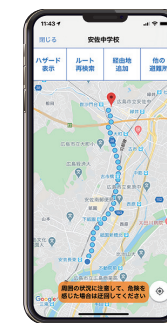
## Helpful Links

Contains a list of links for information about essentials such as water, gas, and electricity, public transport, traffic information, and weather information (may not have multilingual pages available).



## Directions to the Nearest Evacuation Site

Displays directions to your nearest open evacuation site based on your location. Even if you stray from the designated route, or if you've designated places you want to walk by, the app will automatically display new, updated routes for you to follow.



## Disaster Preparedness Information/Notifications

Displays a chronological list of disaster preparedness information and announcements.

## Normal Mode

Displays information to help you stay prepared for disasters, such as weather forecasts, notices from the City, an evacuation site search function, and routes to emergency evacuation sites in your area.
