Press Coverage for the Peace Memorial Ceremony

Coverage for the Peace Memorial Ceremony (herein Ceremony) on Friday, August 6, 2021 must adhere to the following regulations. We thank you for your cooperation.

Inability to adhere to these regulations may result in the rejection of your press coverage application. We appreciate your understanding regarding this matter.

1. Approved Organizations

In principle, permission to cover the Ceremony is granted to the following organizations only:

- (1) Media Organizations
 - Member companies of the Japan Newspaper Publishers and Editors Association
 - Member companies of the National Association of Commercial Broadcasters in Japan
 - Member companies of the Foreign Press in Japan
 - Foreign media organizations that apply via the Foreign Press Center
 - Member companies of the Hiroshima City Press Club (herein City Press Club)
- (2) Others
 - (Public institutions, documentary, filming, and photography companies, etc)

2. Press Passes

(1) Basic Regulations

- a) For security reasons and to ensure the Ceremony proceeds with due dignity, the press is restricted to designated press areas. Those covering the Ceremony in these areas must wear a press pass issued by the City of Hiroshima (see right) and a company armband at all times.
- b) Please make sure to wear the press pass around your neck and the armband on your left arm so that they are clearly visible to security personnel.

We ask that you wear your company armband when filming or photographing following the ceremony.



c) Press areas are color-coded (see Map 1). Please be sure to apply for the appropriate press pass for your designated press area.

Please note that press areas ③-⑥, and ⑨ shown in Map 1 are reserved for the City Press Club only. See *3. Press Areas* for information regarding locations, press pass colors, and restrictions.

 d) Entry is not permitted to the Limited Access Area (see Map 3) without a press pass. Beginning at 5 am, entry to the limited access area is permitted from the west side of the fountain only (including re-entry).

(2) Applying for a Press Pass

- Written Pledge for Press Coverage from the Peace Memorial Museum Rooftop (Attachment 2). Only for those who are applying for a press pass for press area ⑦ (Peace Memorial Museum Rooftop)
- Written Pledge for COVID-19 Infection Prevention Measures (Attachment 3)

Those who submit their Press Coverage Application Form via email will receive a reply with a PDF version of their processed application form from the City of Hiroshima. <u>Please</u> contact us if you do not receive a reply within three days after submitting your application form.

(3) Press Pass Distribution

- Press passes will be issued by the Public Relations Division, City of Hiroshima; please pick them up there.
- <u>Those who submitted their application via email should bring a printout of the processed</u> <u>application form sent to you in reply to your application; this is for identity check purposes.</u> When receiving press passes, recipients are asked to provide their business card. Also, please note that we may check your photo ID (employee ID, passport, etc.); please make sure to bring a valid form of ID.
- Press passes will be issued between <u>9 am, July 27 (Tues) until 2 pm, August 5 (Thurs).</u> If you are unable to collect your press pass during this time due to unavoidable circumstances, please come to the press reception desk within the Ceremony venue between 6:30 am and 7 am on August 6 and we will issue your pass then. <u>Press passes</u> will not be issued after 7 am on August 6.

<u>Please note that as entry restrictions begin from 5 am on August 6 and the only entrance</u> to the Ceremony venue is the westside of the fountain (see Map 3), we expect crowding; therefore, please come with plenty of time to spare.

3. Press Areas (See Map 1 for the locations of each area)

¹ Entering/exiting press areas is not permitted during the specified times. Strictly no access from the central walkway to the Cenotaph or participant seating after 7:30 am.

² <u>Seating limited to seven spaces allocated on a first come first serve basis based on the date we receive your Press Coverage</u> <u>Application Form, which will be defined as the time and date we receive your application made in person or via email.</u>

³ Use of stepladders is not permitted. Furthermore, in consideration of Ceremony participants, please only use the still photography camera stands provided when filming/photographing.

⁴ A member of staff will guide members of the press to film, etc. these portions of the program; please follow their instructions.

⁵ Please meet at the meeting point described on Map 2 by 7:30 am (no entry to the museum after 7:30 am). Please bring and wear a helmet when covering the ceremony. We ask that you do not film south of the park from the Peace Memorial Museum rooftop. Note that when applying for a press pass for press area ⑦ (Peace Memorial Museum Rooftop), applicants are required to also submit a Written Pledge for Press coverage from the Peace Memorial Museum Rooftop (Attachment 2).

⁶ Common-use metal stands will be set up in the northern part of area (8). However, please note that the use of stepladders is not permitted on these metal stands as they disrupt the sound from the loudspeakers.

4. Special Regulations for Coverage

- Out of respect for the participants, we ask that members of the press wear appropriate clothing (for example, white dress shirts and black dress pants). <u>Those covering the</u> <u>Ceremony in press areas (4-6) (Cenotaph Surroundings) detailed on Map 1 are asked to be</u> <u>particularly mindful of this request.</u>
- 2. From 6:00 am until the end of the Ceremony, no filming or photography is permitted in the Access Permitted Area (see Map 3).
- 3. Entering the Cenotaph area at any time, including before and after the Ceremony, is strictly prohibited. In addition, please be considerate of those paying their respects at the Cenotaph and do not, at any time, obstruct the view of the front of the Cenotaph.
- 4. Simultaneous interpretation in English via receiver will be available to journalists sitting in area ① (see Map 1). We ask that you collect your receiver, if necessary, from the press reception desk. <u>Please return the receiver to the press reception desk promptly following the end of the</u> <u>Ceremony.</u>
- 5. If you have any inquiries regarding Ceremony coverage, please confer with on-site City staff wearing armbands marked '報道 広島市' or staff at the press reception desk.
- 6. No traffic is permitted on Peace Boulevard (from the NHK building to west of Nishi-heiwa-ohashi) from 6:30 to 9:30 am on August 6. However, restrictions will be lifted in the area designated by the arrows on Map 5 for press organization vehicles bearing the designated Traffic Pass. Please note that even vehicles bearing the Traffic Pass may be subject to restrictions due to security reasons. Furthermore, no access is permitted to Peace Memorial Park for the duration of the Ceremony; access will only be permitted after 10 am. In addition, the designated Traffic Pass will also be required for vehicular access to Peace Memorial Park from August 1 (Sun) until the end of August 5 (Thurs), as well as outside of traffic restriction times on the day of the Ceremony. Note: excluding broadcast vans and power supply cars, no parking is permitting within Peace

7. Please refrain from covering the Ceremony by air between 7:40 am and 9:15 am on August 6 as it is disruptive to Ceremony proceedings and out of respect for the citizens of Hiroshima. Additionally, flying drones in Peace Memorial Park is prohibited.

5. COVID-19 Infection Prevention Measures

- 1. Only apply for the minimum number of press passes necessary.
- 2. We ask that you refrain from covering the ceremony if you have a fever or even mild symptoms such as a cough or sore throat, or if you have consulted a medical professional or taken medication for cold-like symptoms within the past two weeks and have concerns regarding your health.
- 3. Please submit the Written Pledge (Attachment 3) regarding COVID-19 infection prevention measures.
- 4. To avoid crowding at the venue, maintain social distancing as much as possible.
- 5. Wear a mask at all times inside the venue. <u>Out of respect for the participants, all masks must</u> <u>be white.</u>
- 6. Bring hand sanitizer so that your employees can sanitize their hands appropriately; also make use of the hand sanitizing stations which will be set up in the venue.

6. Press Waiting Room

A Press Waiting Room will be set up in Ran 2 (2BF) of the ICCH between 6:30 am and 12 pm on August 6 (see Map 4). Please feel free to use the electrical sockets in the Press Waiting Room and wireless access points for the Internet. You can also use the wireless Internet in the lobby in front of the Dahlia Room on the same floor.






Press Area ② (Peace Memorial Museum Rooftop) Meeting Point

Coverage is permitted until 6 pm on August 6 (Fri). Filming/photographing after this time is disruptive to those paying their respects; please strictly adhere to this request.




Location of the Press Waiting Room


