

Advance Participant Applications

1) General Seating

Applications will be accepted as follows:

(1) Seats available

Approximately 1,000

Note: should we receive more applications than there are seats, participants will be decided via lottery.

(2) Application criteria

Those who are able to wear a mask during the ceremony, even while seated. Applicants will not be subject to any other criteria.

(3) How to apply

Postcard or other form of postal mail, fax, or online application form

(4) Application period

June 10 (Fri)-30 (Thurs), 2022 (tentative)

Note: details regarding applications are expected to be posted on the Hiroshima City website on Friday, June 10 (we also expect to issue a separate press release by the same day).

2) Seating for *hibakusha* and bereaved family of *hibakusha*

Applications will be accepted as follows:

(1) Seats available

Approximately 250

Note: just as (1) above, participants will be decided via lottery.

(2) Application criteria

Must be a *hibakusha* or bereaved family of *hibakusha*.

(3) How to apply

Same as listed in (1) above.

(4) Application period

Same as listed in (1) above.

Note: just as in (1) above, details regarding applications are expected to be posted on the Hiroshima City website on Friday, June 10 (we also expect to issue a separate press release by the same day).

3) Local government seating (for local governments in Japan only)

Applications will be accepted as follows:

(1) Seats available

Approximately 1,200

Note: should we receive more applications than there are seats, the City of Hiroshima will adjust the number of seats for local government representatives.

(2) How to apply

Applicants must submit a request form (any format) which states the number of seats and other necessary details via postal mail.

(3) Application period

From today until June 24, 2022 (Fri)
