


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# 1 About Credit Transfer

Credit transfer is a system that allows students to take courses and earn credits at universities other than their own university.

- ☀ Studying at different universities provides a valuable opportunity to interact with a variety of faculty and students and to be exposed to new perspectives and ways of thinking.

## 4 Flow from Course Procedures to Credit Recognition



### STEP 1 Confirmation of Credit Transfer Courses

- Check the credit transfer page of Hiroshima Peace Platform to see the courses offered.
- The maximum number of courses and credits that can be recognized for credit varies depending on the university to which you belong. For details, please confirm at the guidance held at your university or at the office in charge.
- Courses may be cancelled due to circumstances at the universities offering the courses, and in some cases, such as when there are too many applications, you may not be allowed to take courses. Please plan your courses carefully so that your requirements for completing the courses will not be directly affected by whether or not you can take the courses. Also, if any courses are cancelled, you will be notified by “5 Class Cancellation Notification Deadline” .

### STEP 2 Application

- To apply, submit the “Credit Transfer Course Application Form” to the office in charge at your university. You can download the form from the credit transfer page of Hiroshima Peace Platform.
- Procedures and periods for submitting application forms vary depending on the university to which you belong, so please check in advance.
- Please submit one copy of the application form per course.

### STEP 3 Confirmation of Course Permission and Tentative Attendance

- Universities offering the courses may make a selection in the case of a large number of applications, etc. You will be notified of the official decision to allow you to take the courses for which you have applied by the office in charge of your university.

- Even if you do not receive notification of course approval by the start of classes, you are required to take courses provisionally at the university offering them.

#### **STEP 4** Official Attendance and Separate Procedures

- If you are approved to take a course, please refer to “6 Separate Procedures” and complete the procedures at the university offering the course.
- Please be careful not to abandon a course after it has been approved.

#### **STEP 5** Credit Recognition

- Grade evaluation is conducted by the university offering the course, and the evaluation is notified to the student’s home university for credit recognition.

#### **⚠** Notes

- There is no charge for taking courses, but please check the syllabus of each course as there may be additional fees for textbooks, etc. depending on the course.
- For other precautions, please refer to “Notes for Credit Transfer Courses” on the next page.

## Notes for Credit Transfer Courses

Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When applying, take into consideration the travel time from your own university or home to the university offering the course.</li> <li>• It should be assumed that courses may not be approved if the courses you wish to take are related to requirements for completing the courses, etc.</li> <li>• For intensive courses, check the vacation period of your university carefully before applying.</li> <li>• Submit one copy of the application form per course to the office of your university within the designated period.</li> <li>• Make sure there are no omissions or errors.</li> <li>• Be sure to confirm the course content on the credit transfer page of Hiroshima Peace Platform.</li> </ul>
Courses and Cancellation of Courses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You should carefully check the dates and times of courses and how to commute to the university offering the course.</li> <li>• Refer to “5 Separate Procedures” in this guidelines and complete the procedures at the university offering the course as soon as possible.</li> <li>• Take courses at the university offering them on a provisional basis until an official decision is made to allow you to take the course.</li> <li>• Do not miss class or abandon the course.</li> <li>• If you wish to withdraw from a course due to unavoidable circumstances, notify your university as soon as possible.</li> <li>• Receive course guidance from the university offering the course.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>① University Guide</li> <li>② How to purchase textbooks</li> <li>③ Locations of cafeterias and how to use the library</li> <li>④ How to check information on class cancellations</li> <li>⑤ How to take attendance, etc.</li> </ul> <p style="margin-left: 20px;">※ Note that each university and instructor has a different way of checking class cancellation information and taking attendance.</p> </li> </ul>
Examination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If there is a conflict between an examination for a credit transfer course and an examination at your university, priority will be given to the examination for the credit transfer course. Receive “Certificate of Examination for Credit Transfer Courses” (Form 10) issued by the university offering the course and take a supplementary exam at your university.</li> </ul>
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If there is a problem at the university offering the course, contact your university immediately.</li> </ul>
