

Announcement Regarding the Special Fixed-Sum Government Cash Benefit

Benefit Details

1) Who is eligible?

Residents who are listed in the Basic Resident Registration System as of April 27, 2020.

2) Who is entitled to receive the benefit?

The head of household for those eligible to receive benefits.

3) Benefit amount

Eligible residents will receive **100,000 yen each**.

4) How to apply

Send in your completed application form, including bank account number, etc, along with copies of your bank account information (bank book, ATM card, etc) and ID (driver's license, Individual Number (My Number) Card, health insurance card, etc) to the City of Hiroshima in the provided reply envelope.

5) End of application period

August 28, 2020 (Fri) (must be postmarked by this date)

6) Application via proxy

Complete and stamp Side B of the application form (Proxy Recipient Form) and send it along with all necessary documents.

Terms and Conditions of the Application Form

- 1) In the process of determining eligibility, we may have to check public records (etc).
- 2) If we cannot determine your eligibility via public records, we may ask you to submit additional documents. We may also check your address of residence in other municipalities.
- 3) If the City of Hiroshima (a) cannot complete the bank transfer because of an error on your application form (etc) and (b) we cannot contact/confirm with the applicant/proxy by the end of the application period, the City shall consider your application withdrawn.
- 4) If you have already received your Special Fixed-Sum Government Cash Benefit from another municipality other than the City of Hiroshima, you shall be required to give it back.
- 5) Should it come to light that, for any reason, any member of the same household OTHER THAN the head of household has received the benefit, you shall be required to give it back.
