

Amended Guidelines for Events Organized by the City of Hiroshima and Temporary Closures (etc) of Facilities During the Continuation of Intensive Infection Prevention Measures

Based on the Continuation of Intensive COVID-19 Infection Prevention Measures implemented across Hiroshima Prefecture, the following guidelines have been amended as of January 18, 2021 (changes are underlined below), and the period of application has been extended to February 7, 2021.

1. Events and Gatherings Organized by the City of Hiroshima*

Events and gatherings organized by the City of Hiroshima will be cancelled or postponed. However, events and gatherings that must be held during the intensive measures period and that are difficult to reschedule will be held in strict adherence to the infection prevention measures described in the [Standard Guidelines for Events and Gatherings Organized by the City of Hiroshima \(revised 11/30/2020\)](#), as stipulated by the requirements for organizing events (etc) detailed in the Continuation of Intensive COVID-19 Infection Prevention Measures.

We ask that all citizens and private entities organizing events and gatherings adhere to these guidelines as well.

*Includes events held by Hiroshima City public interest corporations.

2. Temporary Closures for Facilities in Hiroshima City

- (1) Municipal facilities where large numbers of people are expected to gather will be closed. However, during the intensive measures period, use of some facilities is allowed for those with prior permission and for whom cancellation is difficult.
- (2) Excluding those facilities temporarily closed as per (1) (decided by the Hiroshima City COVID-19 Countermeasures Headquarters on December 11), facilities that remain open after 8 pm will reduce their hours until 8 pm. However, those who have prior permission (etc) to use facilities after 8 pm, and for whom cancellation is difficult, will be permitted to do so.
