Charms of the Walking Trail

The history of Hiroshima began more than 400 years ago during the Period of Warring States, when Mori Terumoto built a castle on a delta and named the area "Hiroshima." Successive lords of the castle, from Mori Terumoto to Fukushima Masanori and the Asano Clan erected shrines and temples in the northeast area, known as the weak point of a castle, aiming to maintain peace in the territory. Some historical shrines and temples on the Walking Trail, which has a long history going back 1000 years, were burned to ashes in the atomic bombing. However, these were rebuilt, and convey the history of our ancestors to this day.
