## Atomic Bombed Trees

1

On August 6, 1945, the first atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima, and the city and its trees were burnt to the ground. It was said that no plants would grow for 75 years after the bombing.

The fact that the atomic bombed trees survived through the horror and new buds grew out of burnt tree trunks gave citizens the hope and courage to live on.

Even now, there remain around 170 atomic bombed trees in 55 places within a 2 km radius from the hypocenter.
